

Skill Merit Camp June 20-23 @ Camp Wilderness

CAMP RULES AND PROCEDURES

- * Lanyards must be worn at all times or you will not be allowed across the bridge.
- * All vehicles must have a completed vehicle registration form on the dashboard.
- * Vehicles are allowed in the campsite to unload gear only. All vehicles must be moved to the parking lot once unloaded.
- * Vehicles may not block any road at anytime. Pull off the road to load and unload.
- * No ATV's, Bike or Golf Carts are allowed other than those approved by the Camp Director prior to Pow Wow.
- * Checkout procedure: Check with your Division Commander for the latest procedures.
- * EVERYONE MUST ATTEND ALL SERVICES. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- * No cutting of any standing trees is allowed.
- * No fires are allowed to be left unattended in campsites.
- * Fires must be in a raised container off the ground, and fire prevention must be near (Water, Sand, Extinguisher)
- * Garbage dumpster will be located near the lodge. Pack out all garbage from your campsite. Garbage can also be dropped off at division HQ on Fri/Sat
- * Saturday Field and Water events will run from 10:15am to 4:00pm.
- * Medical emergencies: contact your division HQ or go to the lodge
- * All knives that are sold in the FCF Village shall be tagged with a two part tag, one taped to the knife the other given as a claim check to the buyer. The knives will be held at the Root Beer stand until Sunday. They can be picked up after the Sunday morning service by an adult.

DRESS CODE

- * Shoes and Shirts must be worn at all times (except swimming).
- * Closed toe shoes must be worn for all water events.

LADIES DRESS CODE AND RULES

- * Tee shirts and shorts must be worn with swim suits. No tank top shirts.
- * No females may be in a campsite without an adult leader present.
- * Shorts mid-thigh, no camis, no tank tops, closed toed shoes
- * All females must be on the lodge side of the bridge before 9:00am and after 5:00pm

Pow Wow Exit Procedures

Before getting vehicles from parking

- Campers must completely tear down their equipment and stack their gear ready for pickup.
- Your camping area must be surveyed and completely cleaned up of debris and ALL trash bags removed from the site (All garbage will be dropped off at the dumpsters on the way out of the property).
- Complete outpost surveys. Find them in your packet or https://powwow.ws/survey
- Outpost coordinators will receive a ticket for each driver from the divisional commander allowing the driver of each vehicle to retrieve their vehicles from the south parking.
- When the vehicle(s) return to the camping area and all equipment is loaded the outpost may then leave the property.

Sunday Exit

- One way road is enforced, leave the opposite direction you came in
- Pick up registration packets/patches after you cross the bridge
- Follow exit signs behind the lodge to throw trash in dumpsters
- Continue northbound to exit via the north gate
- For outposts not needing to dump garbage, they can exit via the main exit
- Any vehicles in south parking not needing to come through camp, may exit via that gate.

Early Exit

- Those needing to leave before Sunday morning must contact their division and arrange a completed and signed early release pass
- Once the pass is arranged, contact security to gain access to the parking lot.
- Security will meet at the designated time to unlock the south gate and allow vehicle retrieval.
- If you are retrieving gear in camp you must exit via the south parking lot
- Do not wait until the last moment to arrange your early exit.

WATER FRONT RULES AND PROCEDURES

The waterfront at Pow-Wow is always a lot of fun for the boys, in order for everyone to be able to enjoy it, participants must adhere to the following rules and policies. Thursday (8am-6pm), Friday (8am-6pm), Saturday (4pm-6pm), and Sunday (8am-4pm) the waterfront is "SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK", there is no lifeguard on duty during these times. During the evening (6pm) to morning (8am) Thursday, Friday, Saturday (until 10am), and Sunday the waterfront will be closed to participants.

- 1. No one in swim area unless Outpost Commander or chaperon from his church is be present in swim area
- 2. Everyone must have closed-toe shoes that cannot come off feet.
- 3. No flip-flops. Must fit tightly or be tied.
- 4. No diving off trampoline or bank. No flips.
- 5. Proper swim attire required.
- 6. Women will wear a colored tee shirt or other cover-up.
- 7. Organized Swim period is 50 minutes. Everyone will exit the swim area at end of period.

Preference for next period to those who have not swam.

- 8. Maximum number of people in area will be enforced.
- 9. When whistle blows, everyone will stop and follow Lifeguard directions.
- 10. Boys/adults not following Lifeguard direction will be required to leave the swim area.
- 11. Buddy System will be enforced. Must have a buddy to swim.
- 12. NO DIVING. No flips or diving off trampoline or bank.
- 13. Swimming only in designated areas (No where along the river except swimming hole)
- 14. If a boy or adult will not leave the area when period is over or if required by the Waterfront Director, that Outpost will not swim again and will be banned from the Waterfront next year.
